Recent Milestones

- First F-16 Block 70, for Bahrain, completes Final Assembly and Checkout (FACO) process in Greenville, SC and moves to paint. (October 2022)
- Lockheed Martin and Hellenic Aerospace Industry jointly deliver the first two upgraded F-16V fighters to the Hellenic Air Force. (September 2022)
- Lockheed Martin mates wing on first South Carolina-built F-16. (August 2022)
- Lockheed Martin and Oman sign agreement to provide upgrades to the Royal Air Force of Oman's F-16s and C-130Js. (July 2022)
